Aldo Giombetti, 68; active in Ashland

ASHLAND Aldo Giombetti, 68, of Alfred Road, died Thursday, Sept. 10, 1981 at Framingham Union Hospital after a long illness.

Mr Giombetti was a retired general foreman for the former Telechron General Electric Co. of Ashland where he was employed for more than 40 years. He also owned and operated the Giombetti Enamelling Co. of Ashland.

He was the first elected member of the Ashland Housing Authority and was a charter member of the Kiwanis Club of Ashland.

Born in Mondolfo, Italy, son of Alfred and Annunziata (Monti) Giombetti, he came to the United States many years ago.

He leaves his wife, Evelyn (Beiyea) Giombetti; two daughters, Mrs. Joseph (Linda) Erba Jr. of Franklin and Miss Martha Giombetti of Ashland; three brothers, Ameideo V. Giombetti of Lunenburg, Rinald Giombetti of Ashland and Armando Giombetti of Medway, and many nieces and nephews.
